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ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, orders have been issued permitting the Chairman, Shree Venkateswara Educational & Charitable Trust, Erode to start two years Health Inspector Course in the name of Shree Venkateswara College of Paramedical Sciences with an annual intake of 40 students per batch / per year, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Training Institute should be affiliated to a Community Health Centre and an Urban Local Body near to the institution in order to provide field practice and required orders shall be obtained from the competent local authority;
- b) The Teaching Facilities, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff, Office, Classrooms, Laboratory, Sanitary Engineering Workshop, Library, Health Education Section should be as per the prescribed guidelines; and
- c) The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine will be the Chairman of the Board of Examination to conduct the examinations of Health Inspector course, subject to the following conditions:-
 - i. The candidates will be informed in writing that successful candidates will not claim as a matter of right, eligible for Tamil Nadu Government Service;
 - ii. The fees prescribed by the Government shall be remitted into Government Treasury for the allotted Community Health Centre / Urban Local Body for field practice training by the Institution; and

- iii. The Institute and candidates should pay the prescribed examination fees at the rate decided time to time by the Board of Examiner.
- iv. The selection rules, curriculum and regulations given in the annexure should be followed without fail and deviation.

d) To submit the Building Plan approved by the Directorate of Town and Country Planning, before admitting the students for the above said course.

2. In the letter second read above, the Chairman, Shree Venkateswara Educational & Charitable Trust, Erode has submitted the representation requesting to enhance the seats of Health Inspector Course from 40 to 80 for their Institute.

3. In the letter third read above, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that in the meeting of the Members of the Board of Examination for Multipurpose Health Worker(M) / Health Inspector / Sanitary Inspector Course held on 30.11.2017, the Minutes of the Board of Examination have approved and recommended for the enhancement of annual intake of seats for the above course from 40 to 80 seats for certain four institutions in Resolution 11/2017, since the four institutions have fulfilled the required infrastructure and faculties and Shree Venkateswara College of Paramedical Sciences is one among the four institutions. Therefore, he has recommended the request of the above Institution for enhancement of annual intake of seats for the Health Inspector Course from 40 to 80 seats as the Institute is having required infrastructure and faculties.

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the recommendation of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in para 3 above and accordingly direct that the annual intake of 40 students sanctioned to Shree Venkateswara Educational & Charitable Trust, Erode for Health Inspector Course in the name of Shree Venkateswara College of Paramedical Sciences be enhanced to 80 (eighty) seats from the academic year 2018-19, subject to the conditions prescribed in G.O. first read above.

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine should ensure that the conditions prescribed at para 4 above are fulfilled by Shree Venkateswara Educational & Charitable Trust, Erode, before admitting the students in the course and to send the report to the Government immediately.


